Developing innovative whole school approaches to food, growing and global citizenship

Friday 17th November 2006, 9.30am - 3.30 pm

Growing Healthy Citizens will introduce a variety of exciting and practical ways for tackling essential requirements of programmes such as Healthy Schools and Citizenship. It will also look at ways of embedding a 'global dimension' and the concept of 'sustainability' across the life of the whole school. The day will provide opportunities for trying out new classroom activities, but will also focus on ways of setting up enrichment and 'Extended School' activities such as cookery and growing clubs. It will also consider ways of linking with local community groups from different cultural and ethnic backgrounds.

Lots of lively, hands-on, workshops, including:

- Setting up Growing Clubs with a global dimension
- Cookery as a doorway into other cultures
- Whole school approaches to Food and Healthy Eating
- What is an Eco-School? And how you can become one.
- Make your school Fairtrade-friendly
